Course schedule

Day 1 (Lectures and hands-on):

- Evolving concepts of meaning of aesthetics. Direct vs. indirect techniques
- Digital diagnostics and communication
- Treatment planning based on digital technology
- New methods and materials for prosthetic reconstructions including in-direct resin based materials
- Indications and limitations of optical impressions
- Minimally invasive treatment concepts clinical criteria for selection of materials and technology
- Workshop: preparations and digital impressions for Resin-bonded fixed dental prostheses veneers and crowns

Day 2 (Lectures and hands-on):

- Indirectly made resin-bonded fixed dental prostheses vs. Implant reconstructions. Complex treatment
- Workshop: Stain and glaze, cementation of Resinbonded fixed dental prostheses veneers and crowns.
- Minimally invasive approach using directly made fiberreinforced composites fixed dental prostheses (Pekka Vallittu)
- Smile design step by step (Aki Lindén)
